2. Innovations in Curricular Design and Transactions

Mother Teresa Women's University introduced the choice based credit system, from the academic year 2008 - 09 as per the recommendations of the Tamilnadu State Council for Higher Education. Faculty members in the Mother Teresa University and the members in the Board of Studies gave their valuable suggestions in designing the curriculum and framing the syllabus. Skill based electives and non - major electives are included in the present syllabus. This facilitate and promote horizontal development. For example, a student of B.A. English Literature studies sericulture offered by the Department of Zoology, Banking Theory, Law and Practice offered by the Department of Commerce, Students from B.Sc Mathematics study English Communication Skills offered by the Department of English.

3. Inter disciplinary programme Continued

Value Education and Environmental studies are given as interdisciplinary subjects.

4. Examination reforms implemented

In the choice based credit system, students' performance is evaluated at the college level by giving periodical class tests and 3 internal tests. According to the university norms, 25 marks are allotted for the internal assessment and 75 marks for the university examinations. For each theory paper 15 marks are given for the test and 5 marks for assignment and another 5 marks for seminar

in the internal assessment. Out of the three internal tests, the best two are considered for the internal assessment.

- Centralised internal tests are conducted.
- The university conducts examination at the end of each semester,
- Practical examinations are conducted for science students by the end of each semester.
- For the Environmental Studies, the students are taken to suitable places on a field trip and they make a detailed study and they are asked to submit a project report, based on their study; marks are allotted for their project work.
- The PG students undertake individual project work. They are evaluated by the external examiners by conducting Viva Voce.
- Visually challenged students are given the assistance of the scribes to write their internal and external examination.

(ii) Career Guidance and Placement Cell :

(v) Anti ragging cell

The Anti ragging cell was established during this academic year and it is functioning effectively. Dr.Mrs.A.Petha lakshmi, Associate Professor of computer science is the staff-in-charge of this cell. A complaint box is placed in this campus to deal with ragging. Counseling classes are conducted for all the students once a week. Proper guidance is given to deal with all the problems of the students by the tutors concerned. As this system functions very well, no complaint has been received from the students regarding ragging.

(vi) Consumer club

Mrs.Christel Jeeva, Assistant professor of History was in – charge of the consumer club. Motivated by the IQAC, an Awareness Programme was organized and 850 students were benefited of it. On 07.03.14, Our principal Dr.Mrs.C.Padmalatha gave the Presidential address. Mr.N.Sheik Dawood,

Secretary, IRCS gave an introductory speech. It was followed by the lecture of Mr. Herald Jackson, Secretary of Consumer Protection Centre who spoke on the six principles of Life. Mr.S.S.Suresh Kumar, President of Consumer Protection Centre enlightened our Students on Bogus Advertisements, Selection of Quality goods and on Purchase of Gold. It was very useful to our students.

(vii) Rotary Club

Under the guidance of the IQAC, the Rotary club in our College functions Meaningfully by arranging different programmes to make the students more sensitive towards the needy. There are 36 Volunteers in the Rotary Club.

From 10.10.13 to 13.10.13, RYLA Camp was organized at Gandhigram Rural University. Two of our students S.Mubeena II B.B.E(E.M) and Hemalatha II B.B.E(E.M) participated in the camp and won many prizes. S.Mubeena got the title MISS RYLA and brought laurels to our college.

On 24.10.13, Polio Eradication Day was celebrated in our college campus. The Queen City Rotary Club and the Rotract Club of our college, joined together in conducting a Rangoli competition which expressed views on eradication of polio.

On 22.02.14, Haemoglobin count was taken to 450 students, with the help of Meenakshi Mission Hospital, Madurai.

Motivated by the IQAC, Women's Day was celebrated in the Open Auditorium of our college. Dr. Rt.P.Kalaichelvi Ph.D, The PRO of Annamalai Open University was the chief guest. She spoke on "ngz; vd;gts;," which brought out the inherent potentialities of a woman and encouraged our students to realise their potentialities and have self knowledge. The students enjoyed the speech which was thought provoking. As per the request from the IQAC, The Queen city

Rotary Club came forward to dig a bore well for 850ft to mitigate the scarcity of water in the campus.

(viii) Lion's Club

The Lion's Club of Temple Bay City has rendered a helping hand towards the welfare of our college. A donation of Rs.45,000 was received from the lions club to purchase Name Boards for the principals, Members of the staff and for the Rank holders. An LCD Screen also was given to our college. To bring out the communication skills and to exhibit their talents, an amount of Rs.55,000 was donated by the Lions club to conduct various competitions. The winners were given cash awards and certificates.

Dr.K.M.Sumathi, Assistant Professor of English was the co-ordinator. Appreciating her services, the Lion's club conferred on her, two awards namely, 'Par Excellence Award 2013' and 'Beyond the Call of Duty -2014'.

(ix) Hostel

A hostel with 275 students is functioning in the campus for the benefit of students coming from far away places. Our Principal Dr.Mrs.C.Padmalatha is the warden of the hostel. Mrs. R.Bhavani, Professor of Zoology is the Deputy Warden. The hostel Committee comprises of the warden, Deputy Warden, a matron and workers who plan and execute everything for the welfare of the inmates. Once in a year, a parents Meeting is conducted and Hostel Day is also Celebrated.

(x) Co-operative stores

The co-operative stores was started under the twenty point scheme of our former Prime Minister Mrs.Indira Gandhi. The stores fulfils the need of the students and the office in providing them with stationary items, Registers and Record Note Books along with the essential things like soap, shampoo, oil etc for

the inmates of the hostel. The canteen also is functioning under the stores where food items and snacks are sold at a moderate price for the benefit of the students. The management of the stores and canteen is appreciated by the authorities of the Co-operative Society, District Collectorate.

The Store committee comprises of Dr.Mrs.C.Padmalatha, the Principal as the president, Mrs.T,Lakshmi, Professor of Chemistry as the vice president, Mrs.P.Gnana Soundari, Associate Professor of Chemistry as the secretary S.Abirami,III BA English Lit as the student secretary and Dr.Mrs.K.Nirmala, Department of Commerce and Ms.V.Rajalakshmi, Department of Economics as members.

Important decisions are taken by the store committee and are implemented. The stores, and the canteen has 4 workers.

(xi) Fine Arts Committee

The fine arts committee in our college makes arrangements for the participation of students in co-curricular activities like oratorical, essay, poetry writing competition and extracurricular activities like dance, song, rangoli, mono acting, mime, mimicry, cooking, painting, pencil drawing, hair do competitions and fashion shows and a variety of entertainments. 16 Competitions were conducted under Fine Arts Dr.Mrs.Thenmozhi, Professor of Geography was in-charge of all the activities and the Student – Secretary Selvi.B.Hemalatha III B.Sc Zoology rendered her co-operation to the activities of the fine arts club.

(xii) Counselling unit

With the encouragement from the IQAC, the Counselling unit in our college functions meaningfully. Dr.A.Pethalakshmi, Professor of Computer Science, Mrs.Sathyabama, Assistant Professor of Zoology, and Mrs.Rajathi, Assistant Professor of Computer Science were in –charge of this. On 18.10.13, a One Day

Workshop was organized in which all the members of the staff participated enthusiastically and found it to be a reviving experience. Dr.K.Alex, Professor of Commerce and a Soft skill Trainer from St.Joseph's college, Trichy conducted the sessions in an interesting manner. His insistence on dedication to duty was amazing. It was useful for all the teaching staff.

(xiii) Population Awareness Club

Encouraged by the IQAC, World Population Day was Celebrated on 26.07.13. A Rally was organised by the District Collector and the students participated in it actively. A Seminar also was conducted on the same day, followed by an oratorical competition. Selvi.R.P.Pandeeswari,II B.B.E and Selvi P.Selvi II B.B.E received prizes from the District Collector Mr.Venkatachalami I.A.S. On 06.02.14, a special meeting was arranged to bring about awareness on 'Environment'. The founder of CEDA Trust Mrs. Packiam Antony delivered a lecture on the preservation of clear environment. It was informative to the students. Dr.Palanirani, Professor of Economics, and Dr.J.Nalatham, Associate Professor of Economics were in – Charge of this club.

(xiv) Grievance and Redressal Cell

To guide the students in the right direction and to listen to their grievances and to counsel them, a Grievance Redressal Cell was formed. Dr.Sumathi, Associate Professor of English, Selvi P.Hemalatha, Assistant Professor of English and Dr.A.Valarmathi were in-charge of this cell. Students are free to contact these staff and share their problems with them and get their grievances redressed.

(xiv) Legal Literacy Cell:

To make the students aware of the Laws for women, a Legal Literacy Cell was formed and Mrs. R.Christel Jeeva was in-Charge of this. Motivated by the IQAC, a meeting was conducted on 29.01.14, in which Mrs. Ramani Mathews, a

leading advocate, delivered a lecture on the awareness of 'Laws for Women'. A Seminar was organized on 30.01.14, in which Mr. Kathir, the founder of Evidence, NGO Organisation gave a special lecture on 'Violence Against Women'. These two sessions were very useful to the students which enlightened them on the laws for women.

(xvi) Research Committee

With the encouragement of the IQAC, a Research Committee was formed with Dr.Mrs.P.Vijaya Associate Professor of English as the President, Dr.Chithra, Assistant Professor of Economics as the Vice President, Dr.C.Florence Annal, Assistant Professor of Geography as the Secretary, and Dr.J.Jayakumari Gnana deepam, Assistant Professor of History as the Treasurer. The committee rendered a worthy service in bringing out a Research Journal of our college. The executive meeting was convened by the principal on 29.08.13 which decided to work towards publishing a Research Journal. It was decided that Dr.G.Arul Selvi Maria Assistant Professor of English was to serve as the Chief Editor of the Journal. Along with her, 5 members of the staff collected the Research Papers and on 14.03.14, the MVM Research Journal was released during the celebration of our College Day. The Staff came forward to contribute their Research Papers for the journals.

Through this Research Committee, our Staff have applied for Research Projects to the UGC. The Committee encourages the faculty members to involve themselves in Research activities.

(xvii) IQAC

The IQAC in our College tries to improve the quality of the institution in all possible ways. It has Dr.Mrs.C.Padmalatha, The Principal as the President, Mrs.G.S.Angelin, Associate Professor of English, as the co-ordinator, and 6 members from different faculties, the Bursar as the administrative officer and 3

members from Local society. The IQAC tried its best to mitigate the scarcity of water in the campus. It got the help of the Queen City Rotary Club and got a bore well of 800ft dug in the campus.

The IQAC met on 19.08.14 and chalked out an action plan to start Extension Activities. After a search, it decided to adopt Government Kallar Hr.Sec.School, Chennamanaickanpatti which was upgraded from High School in the current academic year. When the IQAC approached them, they were happy and asked for a few favours from our staff. Accordingly, the IQAC planned to visit and give support and improve the students of the school in all possible ways. The faculty members co-operated and Sessions were given to staff belonging to different Departments who rendered their service willingly and enthusiastically. The details are given below.


