INDUSTRIAL VISIT (2021 - 2022)

Our College and Naga Limited Foods, Dindigul had signed a Memorandum of Understanding for one year from April 2022 to May 2023. With reference to the MOU, our department had arranged an Industrial Visit to Naga Limited Foods, Dindigul for our students.

A batch of 60 students per day of our department along with 4 staff members visited Naga Limited, Dindigul on 12.05.2022 & 13.05.2022. This visit was arranged for our students to get an exposure on practical hands-on learning of work processes and functions of the industry.

At first, we reported to Mr. Arumugam Muthiah, PRO, in the industry premises. He had taken us to a conference hall and briefed about the history of the industry. Then he introduced Ms. Hema, HR to us. She addressed the students and explained about the procurement of wheat from various places, processing of wheat into wheat flour and other products like Rava, Atta, Maida and Bran, testing the quality of the final products and packaging of the wheat flour and other products.

Then we went to see the various processes taking place in the industry with safety measures. The plant is built in a 7 storey building. We visited all the floors and observed the processes like processing of raw wheat, cleaning, conditioning, cutting, grinding, and milling of wheat into finished products like whole wheat flour, Maida, Atta, Rava and the bi-product, Bran. NAGA flour mills have effective layout machinery. The machine works around the clock 24 hours a day. The machinery and equipment installed are of high quality delivered by Buhler-Switzerland.

We also visited the Quality testing laboratory. There we observed how the quality parameters of wheat were tested by using various tests. Finally we went to visit the packaging section. There we had seen how the wheat flour and other wheat products are packed in small packages ranging from 200grams to 10 kilograms and bulk packages from 10kg, 25kg, 50kg, 90kg and 100kg as per the consumption through its strong 250 plus stockiest network.

Then we went to visit the wet sample unit, where they prepared Noodles, pasta and semiya. There they served cooked pasta to eat. We had eaten the tasty pasta and thanked the PRO and other workers helped to visit the industry in a safe and well manner.

This industrial visit proved highly beneficial for our students in terms of practical knowledge about the industrial processes, quality testing, control, safety, team work and hard work. This visit was also useful for them to find placement in such industries. All the students expressed their thanks to our Principal mam and HOD mam for arranging such a wonderful and essential industrial visit.
