7.1.8 TOLERANCE AND HARMONY TOWARDS CULTURAL

The students are the pillars who shape the future of the country. They need a platform to expose their creativity, talents and their dreams. The institution should provide an inspiring and a positive environment and an uplifting space to the students to exhibit their wonderful talents.

The teachers in our college are committed themselves in motivating, encouraging and tuning the minds of students beyond their normal academic pursuits, to expose their talents in different activities. In the past five years apart from learning, the students were encouraged to participate in various programmes like cultural, commemorating national and international days, awareness programmes, Women's day celebrations, Competitions, department association meetings etc.

The students showed their own brand of multitalented personality, elegance and grace and attracted the audience by their performances. Both on-stage and off-stage bonanzas highlighted the skills of our students emanating from various departments. The valediction complimented and appreciated all the participants and winners for their interest and dedication which added pride to the college. The winners are presented with the trophies and prizes.

Here are some highlights of our cultural events:

1. **Fine Arts Competitions:** The fine arts cultural competitions are conducted every year to help students showcase their talents and creativity. Two days competitions (both on-stage and off-stage) are conducted to nourish various art forms.

Off-stage: Vegetable Carvings, Kolam, Rangoli, Painting, Pencil drawing, cooking (with and without fire), Art from wastes, Tableau etc.

On- Stage: Solo Dance, Group-Dance, Mono-acting, Mime, Fancy dress competition, hair-do, Singing, Indian-cultural dressing etc.

2. Association Meeting, Seminars and workshops: Association meetings in the Department level, Seminars, Workshops and Conferences in the State, National and International levels provide the great opportunities for students to learn about diversity in different fields and it engaged them to involve in interactive discussions and led to gain depth of knowledge in their relative subjects. These academic practices inculcated in them a desire to pursue higher studies and research and influenced them to get academic interests. For example, a one day webinar on ஆரோக்கியம், ஆயுள் பெருக்கும் யோகக்கலை (Yoga for health and sustainable life) was conducted to create interests on yoga.

3. National and International Days: Our faculty members and students have been involved in celebrating National and International days since the last five years. We celebrate International Women's day, World Environmental Day, International Yoga Day, International Dolphin day, World Parrot day, National Birds day, Tiger day, Science day, Butterfly day, Food safety day, E-Poling day etc.

Various competitions are also conducted to promote their interest and prizes are distributed to the winners.

4. Awareness Programme and Campaign: During the pandemic corona period, Corona awareness and yoga awareness programmes were conducted to get an awareness of disease and health condition. Students were encouraged to participate in yoga classes which have been offered by the college.

NSS Programme officers and volunteers conducted campaigns to create awareness among public to get alarm about the unconditional deterioration of environment due to pollution, cutting down trees, exploitation of resources and contamination of our water bodies. Tree plantation programme is carried out to make our environment green and clean.

After the outbreak of pandemic disease - corona, various awareness programmes and competitions were conducted by the Staff and volunteers to create awareness among the public.

- 5. Wild Life Week Celebration:** To commemorate the wild life week, intercollegiate competition was organized and a variety of programmes were conducted for students. The outside participants actively participated in Pencil drawing, painting, Tableau, Mime, Art from waste competitions and the winner were awarded with prizes.
- 6. M.G.R Centenary Function:** To commemorate the Birth Anniversary of the former CM of Tamilnadu – Dr.M.G.Ramachandran, MGR Centenary function was celebrated with all vigour by conducting various competitions.
- 7. THATHA PAATI CLUB: (Grandparents Club):** In order to respect the senior citizens, Thatha Patti Club conducts a programme in our college every year. The grandparents of the students are invited to the college. Besides they are asked to bring healthy and nutritious edible items prepared with cereals, nuts and pulses. With immense interest, they prepare different items on their own, and attend the programme eagerly. They are honoured with prizes.
- 8. Fresher day and farewell day:** In order to invite the fresher, welcome party is arranged for the first year students every year in the odd semester. This builds a beautiful rapport among the senior and junior students of the same department. A farewell function is conducted for outgoing final year III year and II PG students in the even semester.
- 9. Union inauguration day:** E-Polling is conducted to elect 12 students' office bearers. All the students cast their votes using computer terminals. The union inaugural function is held to make the students take the oath on their roles and responsibilities.
- 10. College day:** Annual day celebration is an important event in the college. The achievers and the toppers are appreciated and prizes are distributed to them.

The cultural events provide a platform for students to get opportunities to explore and learn diverse cultures. Students could develop a broader perspective, cultural sensitivity and deeper understanding of the world around them.

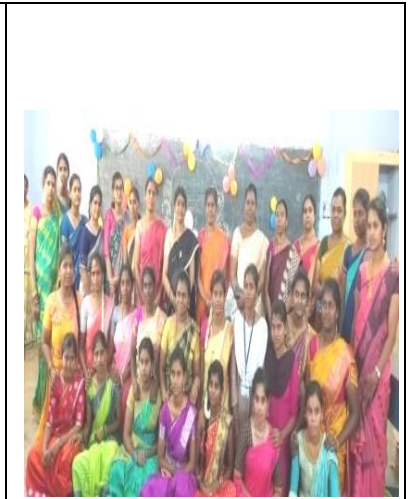
