He advised the students not to a) keep the profile as public b) share personal information c) upload personal photos in social media tools d) download unnecessary apps for various purposes e) click any unwanted, attractive links sent by others f) accept the invite of others without verifying the individual etc. There was a Q&A time at the end of the session.

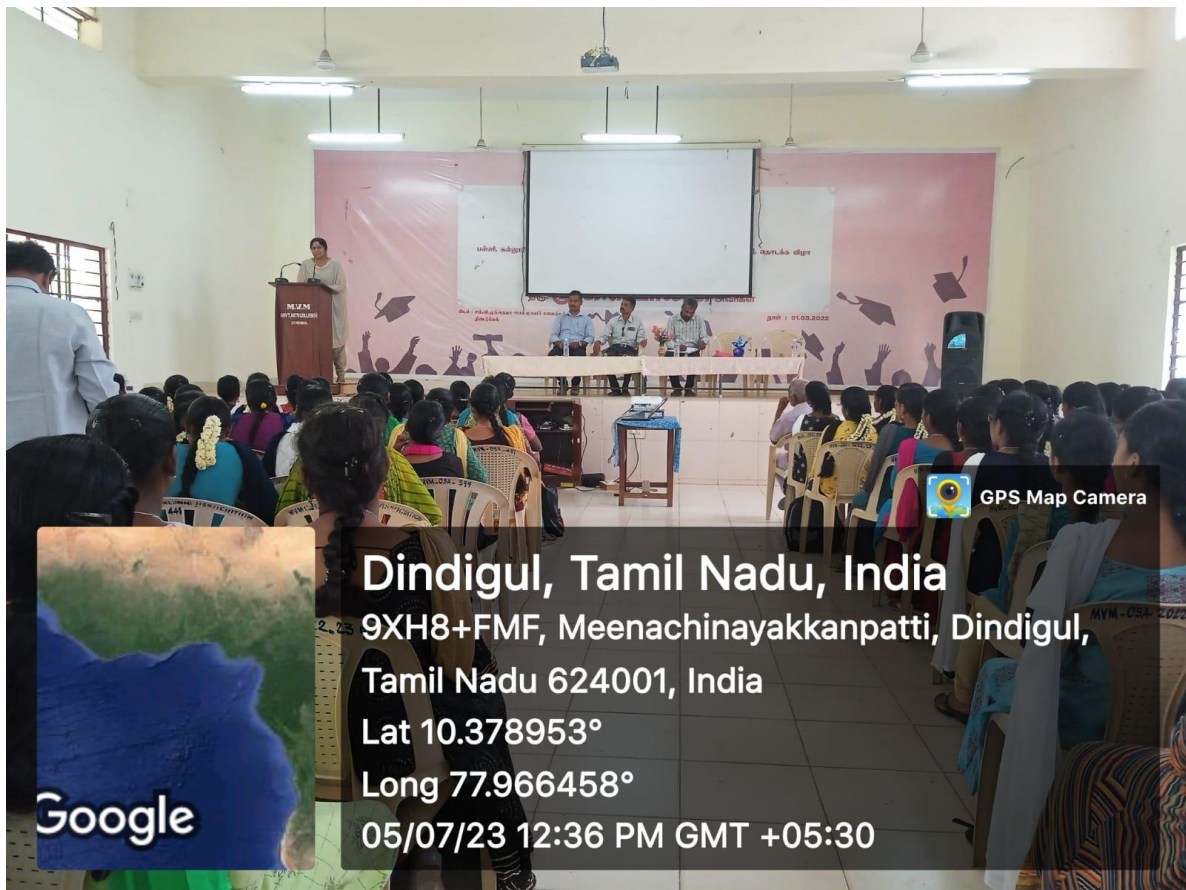
