### MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

M.V. Muthiah Government Arts College for Women is one of the renowned Government institutions in Dindigul, Tamil Nadu. It was established in June 1966 with a mission to Educate, Enrich, Enlighten and Empower for the Emancipation of rural women through Higher Education. The college was named "M.V. Muthiah Government Arts College for Women" to honour Thiru. M.V. Muthiah Pillai, who donated Forty acres of land and Rs 1 lakh to the institution. It is affiliated to Mother Teresa women's university, Kodaikanal and is re-accredited with an 'A'

grade by NAAC in 2014. Since its inception in 1966, the institution enjoys a commendable social accreditation and every year it receives thousands of applications for getting admission in various courses. Institution offers 13 UG, 11 PG, 7 M.Phil and 3 Ph.D Programme for the Students. In addition, the college also offers PG diploma courses in Computer Application and Computer Literacy Programme (CLP) for all the first year Non-Computer Science students. It provides holistic education to the students in a good learning atmosphere.

The college aims to raise the standard of the rural students and economically backward class women by providing quality education .

The Department of English plays a pivotal role in strengthening English Communication Skills (LSRW) of the Students. It was established in 1970 and functions with verve and enthusiasm. It offers UG, PG, M.Phil and Ph.D programme for the students. The Department has a well-equipped English Language Laboratory to aid students to learn, develop and enhance their communicative skills. It creates, conveys and applies knowledge and language skills to the students in order to develop intuitive, personal, academical and industrial skills as a holistic personality.

On the other hand, **Indian Society for the Promotion of English Language & Literature** popularly known by its acronym and hereinafter referred to as **iSPELL** is a society founded in India by like-minded university and college teachers of English with a motto “Facilitate to Elevate” the taste and bliss in the field of English Language and Literature. It aims at providing a platform to blend the trends and mend the minds with the expertise of renowned academicians and of its members to the fraternity and the stakeholders. iSPELL has in its credit successful conduction of various certification courses, FDPs and international conferences in collaboration with prestigious colleges and universities of India enriching and equipping the teachers-learners community with suffice English language skills and profound knowledge of literature.

The representative of Indian Society for the Promotion of English Language and Literature and M.V.Muthiah Government Arts College for Women, Dindigul, agree to this Memorandum of Understanding.

Consequently **MVM** and **iSPELL** (hereinafter jointly referred to as Parties) have agreed to enter into an academic collaboration of multiple curricular and co-curricular activities for the mutual benefits to the constituent stakeholders, particularly for the students and faculty members of the Parties.

This **Memorandum of Understanding** (MOU) is entered into between the parties this May 16, 2022 which witnessed as hereunder.


The purpose of this MOU is to build friendship and goodwill and foster a relationship that will promote mutual intellectual exchanges between students, faculty members and administration of

1. In an effort to experience the lifelong learning press, both parties are prepared to participate in a formal exchange programme that seeks to promote an academic exchange and to provide collaboration in:
  - i. This exchange programme comprises, but is not limited to, the advancement of:
    - a. Exchange of faculty members and students.
    - b. The association of joint research projects and publications.
    - c. Collaboration in the area of education and continuing education including curriculum development and co-curricular activities.
    - d. Conduct of and participation in seminars, conferences, symposiums, workshops and faculty training programmes.
    - e. Other academic exchanges such as Skill Development, Best Practices etc. to which both the institutions may agree.
  - ii. The implementation of any and all exchange programmes will be separately negotiated and determined by both institutions by way of separate agreement and shall be subject to applicable UGC Regulations.
  - iii. Participation in any collaborative event will be resumed as long as both organizations consider it conjointly advantageous and fruitful. It will purely depend on the intent and desire of both institutions to continue such progress oriented and inter-disciplinary knowledge based relations for intellectual growth through the interchange of manpower, intellect and ideas.
2. Both parties are responsible for their own costs in relation to this Memorandum of Understanding unless otherwise agreed upon one common decision.
3. iSPELL and MVM affirm this MOU by the signature of their officials duly authorized to enter into and to implement the same.
4. This MOU will become effective from the date herein mentioned above and shall remain valid for a period of three years unless either Party terminates the same. Notwithstanding any such termination, any programme that is being implemented under Clause 2 (ii) above shall continue till its full completion.


5. This MOU will be reviewed at the end of the third year and subject to mutual consensus may be renewed on such terms and conditions as may be mutually agreed.
